POINCIANA PARKWAY SOUTHPORT CONNECTOR STUDY

For a new transportation corridor from Pleasant Hill Road to Florida's Turnpike in Osceola County

Orlando, FL – Connectivity from Pleasant Hill Road to Florida's Turnpike is the subject of two upcoming public kick-off meetings in September hosted by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT).

This transportation project is a Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study to evaluate alternatives for a new transportation corridor from Pleasant Hill Road to Florida's Turnpike in Osceola County. These public kick-off meetings are intended to aid the FDOT in project development and to increase awareness of community needs, potential issues, and concerns.
